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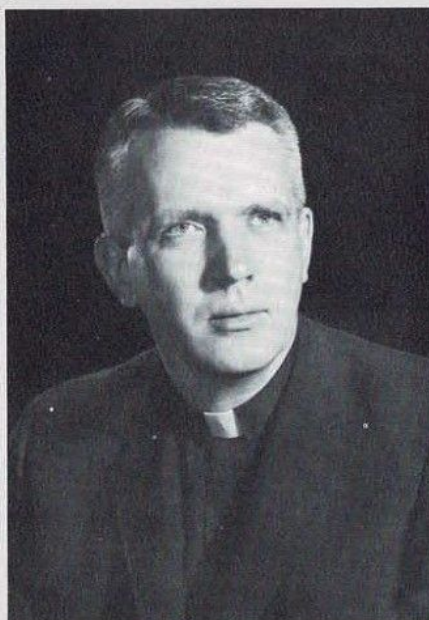




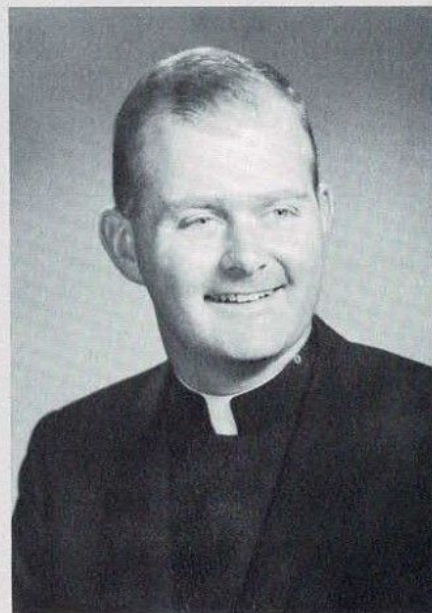
The Sacrament of Baptism is a ceremony of deep religious significance for the new parents, as well as a festive occasion for their families and friends.



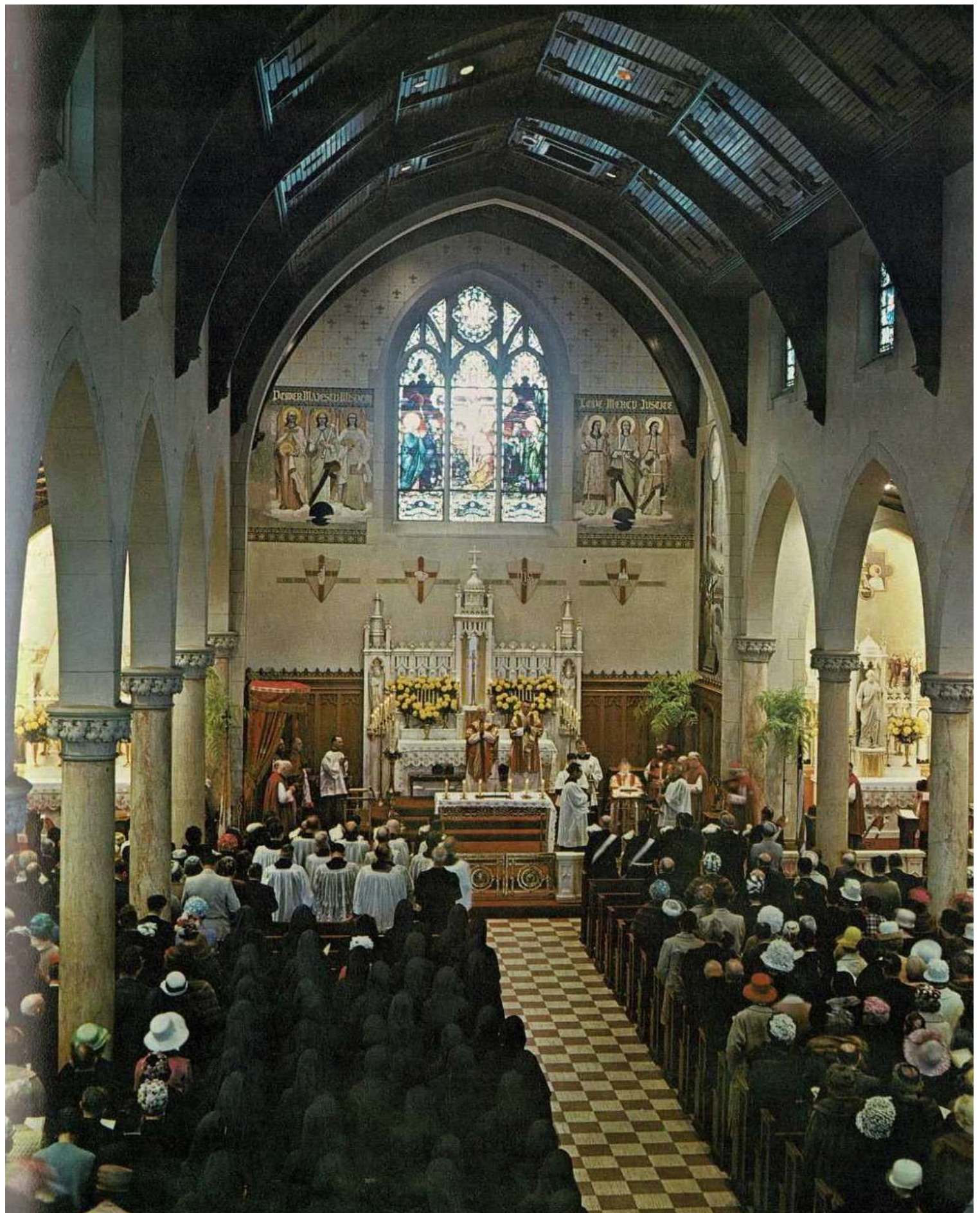

Foreword

On Sunday, April 22, 1917, the Priests and People of the South Western Greenville Section of Jersey City, N. J., celebrated a First Mass at 349 West Side Avenue and gave birth to a brand new Parish entitled Our Lady of Victories.

On Sunday, April 23, 1967, the Priests and People of the Parish of Our Lady of Victories, Jersey City, N. J., celebrated a Pontifical Mass of Thanksgiving to commemorate Fifty Years of service to God and man.

In commemorating these Fifty Years of Divine and Human Service, a beautiful Golden Anniversary Custom Book (in full color) is herewith published. This historical publication is the official record of half a century of religious and civic accomplishments of the Catholic people in this area of Jersey City.

Nearly one million people — including more than ten thousand children, fifty nuns and twenty-five priests — have labored in the Vineyard of Our Lady of Victories during the past fifty years. This in itself is a remarkable record and is fittingly included in this Golden Anniversary Custom Book. Our Parish School alone has an enrollment of twelve hundred children and boasts of the first and enjoys the finest Grammar School Library in the Archdiocese.

Development of the whole child — intellect and will — body and soul — have been and will continue to be the goals of our Educational System. And our scholastic success has not been achieved without attention to the physical needs of the child, as our champion C.Y.O. teams will attest.

The sick — the dying — the troubled and the destitute — the faithful and the careless — the saint and sinner — all have received love and attention during the years. This has been our life. This is our story and your story and we are very proud, as you certainly are, to be part of it.

In the names of Father Robert Lennon, Father Walter Swenson, Father William O'Brien and in my own name — Cordial Congratulations.

And may the Great Love the Good Lord has for each of us — increase and sanctify the love we have for one another.

OUR LADY OF VICTORIES CHURCH: FIFTY YEARS OF CHANGE AND GROWTH

In this year of Our Lord, Nineteen Hundred and Sixty-Seven, with pride in our Faith and gratitude in our hearts, we commemorate the Fiftieth Anniversary of the First Mass celebrated in our parish. The celebration of this First Mass on April 22, 1917, marked the Canonical Establishment of the new parish under the maternal protection of a glorious title of Our Lady Of Victories.

It was most fitting that the new parish should bear the title of Our Lady of Victories for its formation and consequent development were a spiritual victory for the Catholic people in this part of the Greenville section of Jersey City.

Beginnings

For many years Catholics in our area had attended St. Aloysius Church. With the growth of the city it soon became a metropolis and by 1917 it became necessary to consider the formation of a new parish.

In the fall of 1916 the Pastor of St. Aloysius Church, Rev. James J. Hall, realized that things could no longer go along in the old way. With the permission of the Bishop of the Diocese of Newark, the Most Reverend John J. O'Connor, Father Hall established a Mission in this part of town and the nucleus of our parish was formed.

With great promptness, Father Hall bought the building of the former Wickens' Sash, Door and Blind Mill at 349 West Side Avenue. Of course, fundamental alterations were needed in order to transform the commercial structure into a church. The changes were made quickly, and on April 22, 1917, Father Hall celebrated Mass in the new church. The Parish of Our Lady of Victories was Canonically established. An interesting note here is the fact that the Most Rev. John J. Dougherty, S.T.L., S.S.D., Titular Bishop of Cotena, now Auxiliary to the Archbishop of Newark, served as altar boy at this First Mass.

On January 1st, 1919, Rev. Thomas J. Hampton was appointed as the first resident Pastor of Our Lady of Victories.

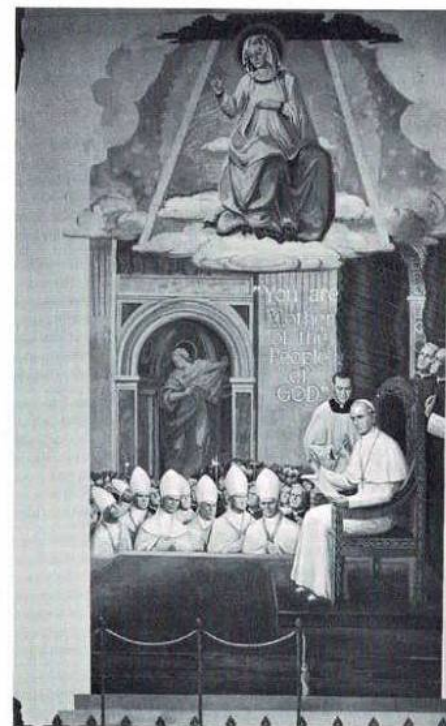

Early Expansion

Father Hampton found a parish whose Catholic population was growing by leaps and bounds. The great expansion of our parish and of Jersey City in those days was part of a tremendous national upsurge. Those were the days of World War I, when Europe was in upheaval and here in the United States a vital population growth was taking place. About this time the flood of peoples from the Emerald Isle and from sunny Italy reached its high tide on our shores.

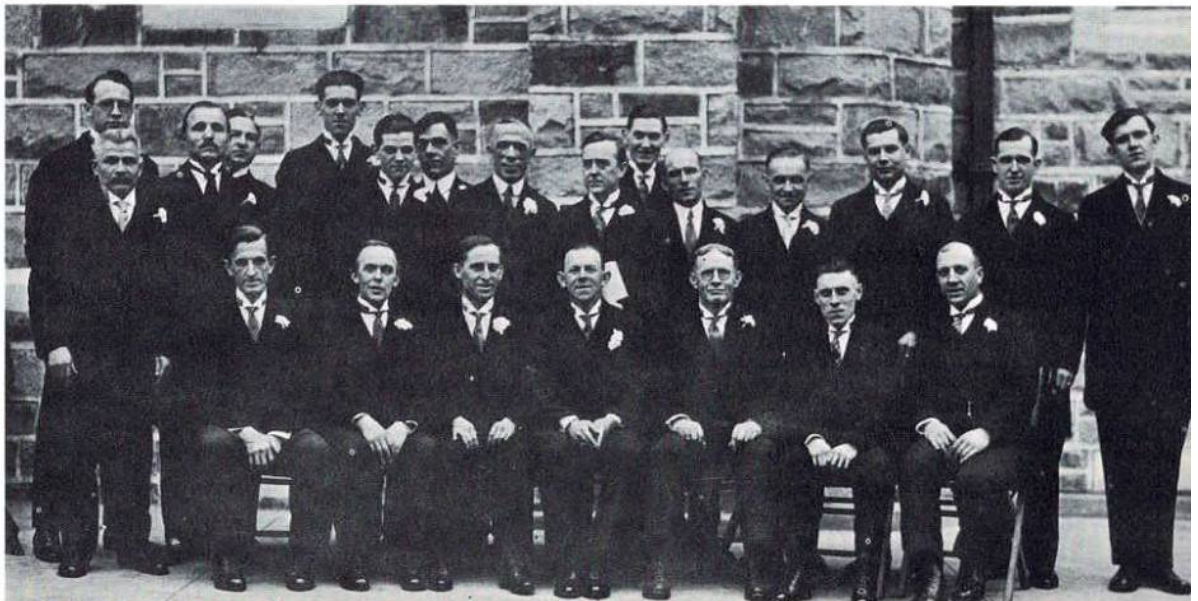
The Black Tom explosion of World War I had taken place on the Jersey City docks only three months before the formation of the Mission of Our Lady of Victories in the fall of 1916. About seven years prior to this time, Jersey City had been made easily accessible by the opening up of the Hudson Tubes from downtown Manhattan to Exchange Place. Rapid expansion, economic and social, was in the very air. The population of Jersey City was almost 300,000, and in any other part of the United States it would have been recognized as a metropolis. Because of its proximity to Newark and New York City, however, its size did not appear so great in comparison with these enormous centers of population.

The expansion of Jersey City had its social and ecclesiastical results in our parish. Here the newly-arrived immigrants found a friendly and progressive city, for here their own people welcomed them with open arms.

The New Church

And so in 1921, encouraged by the growth of his parish, Father Hampton acquired the present site of our church, at Hudson Boulevard and Ege Avenue. He also bought a modest home at Claremont and West Side Avenues which he transformed into a rectory for himself and his Curate, Rev. Francis J. McElhone.

A proud group of ushers were in attendance at Our Lady of Victories' first Mass.





A happy Msgr. O'Brien is most grateful for the combined efforts of our dedicated Book Committee who were responsible for the success of our campaign and for this beautiful Custombook edition on our Church and Parish.

His Curate, Rev. Francis X. Daisy, was appointed Administrator, and the plans for construction were delayed when Father Brennan died in the early part of 1926, much mourned by his parishioners.

The Rev. Thomas F. O'Donnell was then appointed Pastor of Our Lady of Victories. Father O'Donnell came from St. Andrew's, Westwood, with the whole-hearted intent of carrying on the work of Father Brennan. Within a year the rectory was finished, and Father O'Donnell and his new Curate, Rev. Robert F. Marnell, took up residence.

This period in the late Nineteen-Twenties marked another boom cycle in Jersey City. The Holland Tunnel, completed in 1927, linked Jersey City more closely than ever before with New York. Moreover, bus lines began to spread throughout Jersey City itself and transportation became easier and swifter. Land values shot up into the sky like the

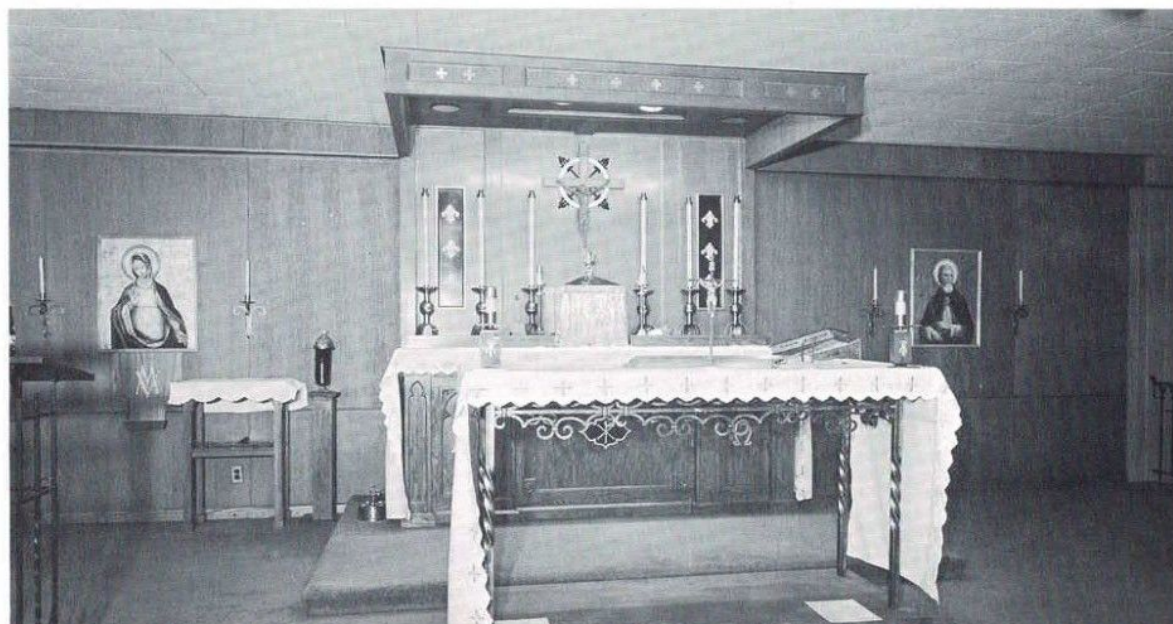


The St. Cecilia Girls Choir provides a musical outlet for girls who have outgrown primary grade singing groups.

In accordance with Vatican II, the altar in the lower church allows the celebrant to face the people, dramatizing the active presence of Christ through His minister.



After the opening of the new convent it seemed that the parish was complete. But the continued growth of home building in our parish brought an influx of new parishioners, and soon the school became overcrowded. Necessity caused Monsignor Coyle to build new classrooms in the auditorium. He constructed four rooms at first but only a few years later he had to add two more rooms to the auditorium, and twenty-two classrooms to the school building.

During the construction of the last two rooms in the auditorium, Monsignor Coyle died. He had not spared himself in his work for the parish. Indeed, as representative of the Archdiocese of Newark, he had just returned from the Annual Easter Conference of the National Education Association. Monsignor Coyle's passing was a great loss to the parish.

In May, 1959, Archbishop Boland appointed Father Leo Martin as Pastor of Our Lady of Victories. A few months later, in December 1959, Archbishop Boland also made Father Martin a Prelate of the Church.

Monsignor Martin realized the need of acquiring new property to extend the facilities of the church. Accordingly, he launched an "Increased Revenue Drive" but, before it could be completed, he was made Pastor of St. Mary's in Bayonne.

Thus in October, 1961, Father John O'Brien was appointed Pastor of Our Lady of Victories. Father O'Brien had spent twenty-nine years in All Saints, Jersey City, and he came to our parish with a wealth of experience, ready and eager to carry on the work and the ideals of his predecessors.

Father O'Brien promptly secured and combined several tracts of land between Ege Avenue and Kearney Avenue. On this property there were two fine houses which were improved and modernized for the church sextons. At the rear of these houses a large area was paved with asphalt to create a much needed parking space for cars.

Once more the school was expanded. Two more classrooms were added and a music room was outfitted. Our school now has three classrooms for each grade.

On December 20, 1964, Archbishop Boland elevated Father O'Brien to the rank of Domestic Prelate with the title of Rt. Rev. Monsignor.

Among Monsignor's new construction projects were a completely revamped basement chapel with a seating capacity for 900 people, and a beautiful baptistry, complete with murals and Italian marble.

Monsignor O'Brien has also modernized the library of our school and has made it, for its size, second to none in the Archdiocese. On its shelves there are five thousand books for children, with the number increasing monthly. An additional reading room became necessary and has been installed in the basement. Ours is the only parochial grammar school library in Jersey City which has after-school hours supervised by the Sisters of Charity.

Progress and Vatican Council II

When Monsignor O'Brien came to Our Lady of Victories, our historic Vatican Council II was at its height. The *Document on the*

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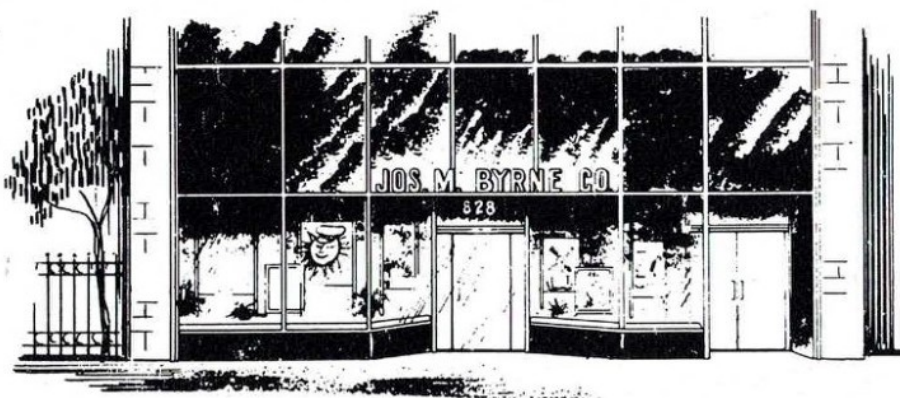
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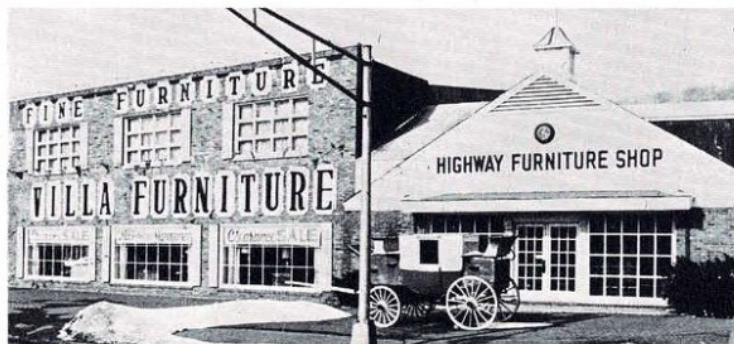
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
