#### CATHOLIC CULTURE

Every Mass and almost every liturgy and communal prayer of Catholics begins with the words and gestures of the Sign of the Cross. This prayer formula proclaims our belief in a Trinitarian God in whose communion we share: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Blessings are also frequently rendered in a Trinitarian formula, whereupon Catholics sign themselves with the Sign of the Cross.

The early ecumenical councils of the Church were called in order to deal with heretical teachings regarding the Trinity. The Councils of Nicea and Constantinople I produced the Niceo-Constantinopolitan Creed, or simply, the Nicene Creed (ECathDoct 683). We proclaim this profession of faith every Sunday at Mass.

The following prayer expresses a mystical depth of communion with the Trinity: "O my God, Trinity whom I adore, help me forget myself so to establish myself in you ... as if my soul were already in eternity. May nothing be able to trouble my peace or make me leave you ... but may each minute bring me more deeply into your mystery! Grant my soul peace. Make it your heaven, your beloved dwelling ... May I never abandon you there, but may I be there, whole and entire ... adoring ... given over to your creative action". (ElizTPry)


